## **Admission Process:**

(One month should be more than enough for you to go through the whole process)

Online application with requested documents:

- \* Résumé
- \* Cover letter
- \* Copy of most recent degree and transcripts
- \* Copy of ID card (passport)
- \* English/French proficiency test
- \* Letters of recommendation (optional: maximum 2)

Make a **50** € payment of "application fee":

(online or bank transfer)

This step is necessary in order to validate your application

Our recruitment committee will receive and review the application.

If anything is missing, we'll be in touch with you promptly.

If the application meets eligibility criteria, the candidate is contacted to schedule a Skype interview.



After a few days, the candidate receives the final answer of his/her admission process and the final steps to confirm registration if accepted







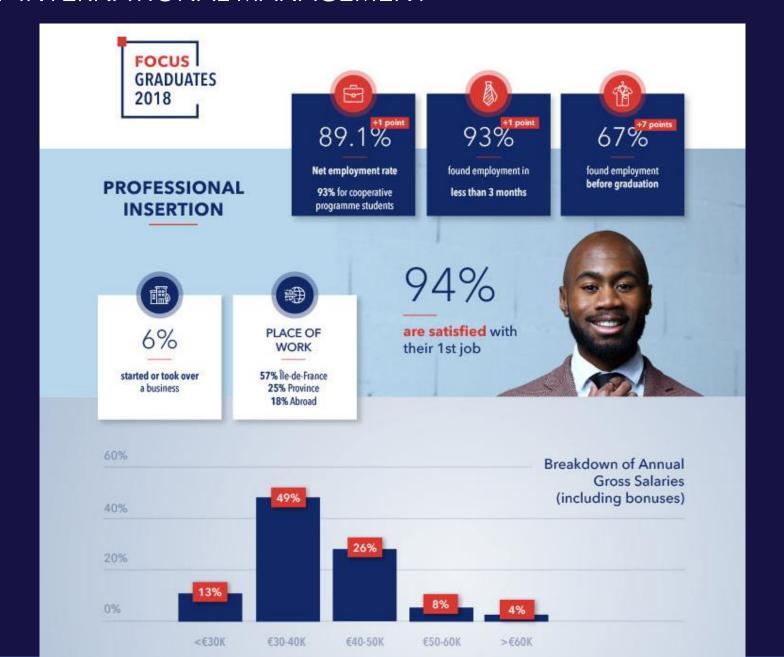

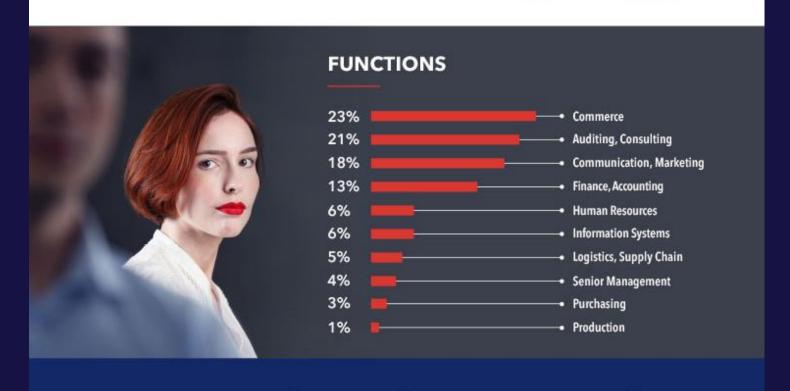
